I recently got to try out [Jolly Llama's new squeezable whole fruit sorbets](#). As my family and I are very fond of the frozen treats, we were eager to give them a whirl!

What they say:

- they come in fun-to-eat individual 3 oz. squeeze-up tubes
- all natural (no genetically modified corn sweeteners)
- low in fat and average just 75 calories per serving
- high in fiber and vitamins A & C
- four flavors: strawberry, mango, acai, blueberry
- available nationwide for home delivery thru the company's website
- currently in grocery stores throughout the Western US



What we say:

YUM! I set up a taste test for my family so we could try every flavor. They were a huge hit. My kids were gobbling them up and asking for more - and so were the adults. I LOVE the acai berry one - so yummy. And it had me at "70 calories." My husband and younger daughter both preferred the mango, while my older daughter liked strawberry. My 19-month-old son liked them all and was sporting a bluish-purple mustache after inhaling the blueberry one and kept giving himself brain freezes from eating too fast.

I love the ingredient lists: all natural. Real fruit, sweetened with pure cane sugar, plus vitamins A & C and fiber. Now that's a dessert I can feed my kids.
